HEARTLAND CHAPEL

At the southeast corner of 5th and north Robinson, immediately east if the National Memorial stands a small, open-air chapel. Very soon after the bombing on April 19, 1995, it became obvious to the pastor of the United Methodist Church at this location. that there was a need for a place where friends and family and those visiting the bombing site could sit, pray and meditate. This chapel is approximately 16 x 18 feet, with wood beam supports and a shingled gabled roof. The flooring is wood planking and there are two kneeling rails and benches. A cross sits on an altar at the front of the chapel. The altar was built with actual bricks from the demolished Federal Building.
