## **HEARTLAND CHAPEL**

At the southeast corner of 5<sup>th</sup> and north Robinson, immediately east of the National Memorial stands a small, open-air chapel. Very soon after the bombing on April 19, 1995, it became obvious to the pastor of the United Methodist Church at this location, that there was a need for a place where friends and family and those visiting the bombing site could sit, pray and meditate. This chapel is approximately 16 x 18 feet, with wood beam supports and a shingled gabled roof. The flooring is wood planking and there are two kneeling rails and benches. A cross sits on an altar at the front of the chapel. The altar was built with actual bricks from the demolished Federal Building.



## **20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Oklahoma City Bombing of the Murrah Federal Building**

This April marks the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this tragedy that marks a time that changed all of our lives forever. The Chapel is in need of refinishing of some of the woodworking in this special place our club created. The weather, over the years, has been hard on the finish and turned a lot of it grey.
