AFFAIR OF THE HEART



Exhibiting regionally and nationally, Willard Stone gained world-wide recognition for his stylized figures of humans and animals created from a variety of locally grown wood and occasionally cast in ceramic or bronze. Stone's work is preserved in public and private collections throughout the U.S. and abroad. On February 29, 2016, Willard Stone would have celebrated his 100th Birthday.


