A special " thank you" to all the club members who continue to support our community project.

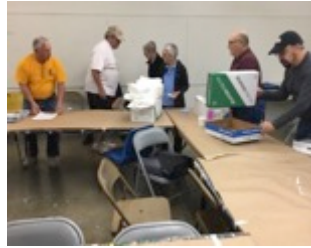
