## Spangler Award 2017

On October 29, at the Sunday, Artistry in Wood, breakfast, John Amicon, presented John Luna with the Spangler Award for outstanding service to the Club by a Club member. John Luna has earned the award for his tireless efforts promote the club, to teach carvers, young and not so young, and to promote woodcarving. The Award was created in 1980 and named for Glenn A. Spangler one of the most active and effective members of the early OCWC. Glenn Spangler carved mostly animals and became well known through the region for his efforts to promote woodcarving and the OCWC. The recipient each year is selected by a committee made up of all the previous award winners who are current members and have attended at least half of the meetings during the year. The Award comes with a trophy that stays with John for the next year and is engraved with the names of the previous winners. Also the winner receives a beautiful medallion engraved with his name on the reverse side.
