Topic: **Chip Carving with Gerald Hudson**Gerald will give us the details of how he does those beautiful chip carvings which are his specialty.

At our April meeting, Fred Self gave an interesting and detailed demonstration on how to paint a carving by brushing on acrylic paint and then following up with an airbrush. He carved an ear beforehand for the demo.



First, he mixed together several different colors of acrylic paint to create a flesh tone.





After he finished applying it to the ear, he decided to paint the hair brown. When it was completely dry, he used a dry brush to add the highlights. He also used brown paint to darken the ear canal. After everything was dry, he airbrushed in the shadows using watercolor paint.





During the demo, he talked to us about which types of paint work best and the quality of the materials and equipment that should be used.





Fred also brought several nice examples of his painting. It was a pleasure and a privilege to watch him at work. We hope that he'll follow up with a painting workshop where we can try our hands at it while getting his expert advice.
