Marvin also received 1st place in the miscellaneous category for his chip-carved Christmas tree topper, and 2nd place in the miscellaneous open category for his chip-carved sled ornaments.

Tom uses various types of wood for his fly boxes. Before burning the design into the top of a box, he practices on a piece of scrap wood, as shown above. The names of the people receiving the boxes are burned into the wood, as well. He puts his initials, date, and type of wood on the bottoms of each.

Dr. Steven Robert Brandt, 62, passed away September 28, 2020 at home, surrounded by family and friends. He was born December 1, 1957 in Great Bend, Kansas to George Robert Brandt and Dr. Ruth Brandt (Waller).



Steve grew up in Edmond, Ok. He graduated from Edmond Memorial High School in 1976, earned a B. S. degrees from Oklahoma State University, and a D.D.S. degree from Oklahoma University. He was a member of Sigma Chi Fraternity, a Freemason, Oklahoma City Woodcarvers club and an active member of the Comanche Little Ponies Powwow Club. Dr Brandt had a career in dentistry in north Oklahoma City for over 20 years.
