Dick Faulkner presented an outstanding program on bird carving at our last meeting. He talked briefly about the different types of birds, such as waterfowl, birds of prey, and game birds. He also discussed the differences between decoys and decorative carvings and stylized versus realistic.







One of Dick's decorative waterfowl carvings

He stressed the importance of planning and talked about the best ways to work with different types of woods, the importance of using good patterns, and using quality photographs as a resource.

During the presentation, he gave us a few good tips on how to cut out a pattern on a bandsaw. Other topics that were discussed included the importance of drawing a center line, as well as having the eyes symmetrical and how to accomplish that.





Dick also recommended using books about drawing birds for reference. He also told us a little about

woodburning the feathers, setting the eyes in place, making the bird's feet, and creating its



habitat. He wrapped things up with a short discussion on using oil paint as opposed to

acrylics. All in all, it was an enjoyable and informative program, and we are grateful to Dick for



sharing his knowledge with us.
